While I am sitting writing this newsletter, I am looking out of my office window watching the power and beauty of God. It has rained here at home for about 36 hours straight and when I say rain, I mean that rain that comes in sideways. Sharon and I have been sitting on pins and needles just waiting for another tree to fall. While we are waiting, we are also trying to entertain our two year old granddaughter, Flora. Her father, our son, and his wife, are out rescuing people; some just get stuck in a bad situation and some who are just not making smart (ok dumb) decisions and trying to do things they shouldn't be doing.

It was a long 5 hours, and now I have decided to sit back down and finish my newsletter. Let me start by saying, "Praise the Lord" all my family is safe, at least for now. All of us have had some damage. Peyton had multiple trees fall on her back deck and fence, Brad's fence was taken down by trees and his shed had a tree on it and finally the worst may have been Wes's house who had a tree fall on it. Wes has not had any time to really evaluate it because he is out taking care of everyone else in need.

Now I tell you all this to say that even in this storm, God showed his face and I'm sure he will continue to over the next few days. What I heard in the sermon at the church I attended, in Denver, CO, was that God never makes evil or bad things happen, but he can use it to serve his purpose. I saw God right after that storm when just a couple of hours after it calmed down, five neighbors pulled up in my driveway and got out with chainsaws and began cutting the tree up that was blocking my driveway. They did in about two hours what it probably would have taken me two days. My son has told me stories of how people have come out of their homes to help clear roads from downed trees that his rescue service needed to get through to get to someone who was stuck in a mudslide. This past Sunday I asked everyone to keep their eyes open for God because He will always show up during a storm. Doesn't it seem like we see the best in people when things are at their worst?
